

# ALIANZA DRESS CODE

## Alianza Uniform:

All students must wear the school uniform to school every day, as established in the Alianza Charter School Plan.

## Purpose:

The Alianza Dress Code is designed to promote school pride, and a learning environment that is safe for all students.

## What can you wear?:

- **Tops:**
  - Any solid white or gray. All Alianza shirts are OK.
- **Bottoms:**
  - Solid navy blue or black. Gray and white stripes are OK.
- **Jackets, Sweaters Hats & Caps:**
  - Solid white, gray, black, navy blue, and brown. Stripes in these same colors are OK.
- **Shoes:**
  - Toes must be covered. Shoes must be appropriate for PE.
- **Bags & Backpacks:**
  - Any combination of white, gray, black, navy blue, and brown.
- **6<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Additions:**
  - All of the above, plus navy blue tops and khaki bottoms.
- **Free Dress Day:**
  - The last (school) Friday of the month is a free dress day.
  - Individual picture day is a free dress day. (Group pictures require a uniform.)
  - All restrictions below apply to Free Dress Day.
- **Dress Up Days:**
  - Theme dress days are NOT free dress days. The options are to wear the dress theme or a uniform.

## What you may not wear:

- **Prohibited on clothing, shoes, jewelry and accessories:**
  - Red or blue (exception: Alianza Navy Blue dresses or pants).
  - Logos, designs, letters or numbers.
  - Bandanas, spikes, or chains.
- **Tops:**
  - No tank-tops, see-through, or half-shirts that expose the back, chest, shoulders or midriff.
- **Bottoms:**
  - Skirts or shorts must be at least as long as the level of your finger-tips, with your arms straight down at your sides. No exposed underwear or area below the waist.
- **Hats & Caps:**
  - Heads may not be covered while indoors (except for religious reasons).
- **Shoes:**
  - No steel-toed shoes of any kind.
- **Violations:**
  - Clothing or personal possessions that violate the Dress Code will be confiscated and held for pick-up by a parent or guardian.
  - Students who must remove clothing will have the option of calling a parent/guardian for a change of clothing, or using an item borrowed from the Alianza office (as available).
  - Students who are unable to comply with the Dress Code after being sent to the office will be sent home, pending notification of a parent, guardian, or emergency contact.
  - The third and subsequent Dress Code violations will earn the student detention.
